## Physically Challenged Appeal Board

The Physically Challenged Appeal Board (PCAB) is comprised of five members.

**All members shall reside in the City of Gilroy.**

Two members of the Appeal and Review Board shall be physically challenged persons or shall be persons with a close relationship with a physically challenged person.

Two members shall be persons experienced in construction and one member shall be a public member.

**The City is looking for a member with experience, either directly or indirectly, in construction.**

Terms of appointment to the Appeal Board shall be for a term of two (2) years.

The PCAB acts in the capacity as a review board of appeals made by applicants/developers on new construction for non-compliance with requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The decisions of the PCAB are final on appeals unless their decision is further appealed to the City Council.

The PCAB will be expanding their role to review and provide ADA recommendations on City Public Works projects such as sidewalks, cross walks, parking and facilities. The Board typically meets quarterly for approximately one hour during the work day.

Applications are available at the administration counter for citizens interested in taking an active role in regard to compliance with the American with Disabilities act.
